The Russia forward is expected to arrive in London in the next 24 hours to complete a £12.5 million deal from Spartak Moscow, potentially ending Tottenham's taxing search for a target man as a replacement for Dimitar Berbatov

Jermaine Pennant to Blackburn Rovers

James Milner to Aston Villa/Liverpool

The midfield player has given in a transfer request at Newcastle United in a bid to move to Aston Villa or Liverpool. He was close to moving to Villa Park on deadline day two years ago, but the £4 million deal collapsed at the eleventh hour

Vedran Corluka to Tottenham Hotspur

Tottenham are still keen to sign the defender, who had a medical with them, but Manchester City withdrew from the deal

Albert Riera to Liverpool

The Espanyol winger made little impact during a loan spell at Manchester City in 2006, but will be expected to bring some width and penetration to Liverpool's attacking play
